Bill and Mary Noel's philanthropy has focused on Catholic education, Catholic health programs and Catholic Charities for the Diocese of Arlington and the Archdiocese of Washington.

Bill and Mary Noel have been married for 49 years, are the parents of four children, and enjoy spending time with their nine grandchildren.

Sister Mary Bader has been a member of the Daughters of Charity for 27 years. Her various ministries have focused on vulnerable children and families. She currently serves as CEO of St. Ann's Center for Children, Youth and Families, an organization that provides supportive residential programs for homeless mothers and their children, and for pregnant and parenting teens.

Prior to entering the Daughters of Charity, Sister Mary taught at Our Lady Queen of Peace in Washington, DC and worked concurrently at St.

Ann's in multiple roles as a teacher, tutor, and summer program coordinator.

As a Daughter of Charity, Sister Mary has taught in Catholic grade schools in rural West Virginia, Richmond, and Baltimore. In Baltimore she served as the principal of Mother Seton Academy, a Nativity Model, tuition-free middle school for boys and girls.

Sister Mary holds a B.A. in Child Study from Tufts University and a M.S. in Education from The Catholic University of America. She has served on the boards of schools, hospitals and other organizations including Georgetown Visitation, St. Anselm's Abbey School, Loyola Blakefield High School, Providence Hospital, Providence Foundation Board, St. Vincent's Hospital, SOME and Mission and Ministry, Inc.
